Please remember the impact term time absence can have on a child's learning. The image below illustrates the effect that absence has on a child's percentage attendance and the number of actual lessons they miss during their holiday.

95% ← Attendance	→ 2 ← Weeks Absent	> 50 Lessons Missed
90% ←	→ 4 ← Weeks Absent	→ 100 Lessons Missed
85% ←	→ 6 ← Weeks Absent	→ 150 Lessons Missed
80% ←	→ 8 ← Weeks Absent	→ 200 Lessons Missed
75% ←	→ 10 ← Weeks Absent	> 250 Lessons Missed



We would like to share with families some information we have received from Amazon in Darlington.

Amazon Book Hunt

As part of the Global Month of Volunteering (May) and National Great Outdoors Month (June), Amazon Darlington have teamed up with The Literacy Trust to get children reading and active outdoors!

Amazon have donated in excess of 500 books for our teams to prepare (bag up and seal from the elements) in May and then hide in South Park

Darlington on the evening of June 22nd 2024. These will then be ready for primary school children from the local area to find, take home and enjoy the following morning (Sunday 23rd June).

Frequently Asked Questions:

Is there a cost to attend?

No - this event is being entirely funded by Amazon Darlington

Where will books be hidden?

Books will not be hidden in areas where anyone could damage the park – please remind attendees to respect the park, foliage and planted areas at all times.

Will each child be guaranteed a Book?

No – we will be hiding in excess of 500 books in the park and these will be on an entirely first come-first served basis – it is our hope that each child only takes one book home each so as to leave enough for everyone to find one.

What sort of books will there be to find?

Amazon have teamed up with The Literacy Trust and have purchased a wide range of books covering all ages between 4-11. There will be something for everyone.

Will Amazon be in attendance at the event?

No – this initiative is entirely hands off, we will supply and hide the books the evening before but will not be present on the day.

What do we want from you?
