At Holy Family we like to celebrate and promote good school attendance and punctuality.

Each week, the class with the best attendance are rewarded with an additional activity and our attendance stars are also shared on the weekly newsletter.

As we start a new term, we would like to share with families some information produced by Bishop Hogarth Catholic Education Trust, in association with the Trust's attendance policy.

We have also included below some useful information about absence and appointments.

Attending School

Please try and ensure that your child is in school as much as possible and that they arrive before registration so they don't miss the start of their school day.

Concerns

If at any time your child is concerned about anything or anxious about attending school, please contact us so we can help.

Appointments

We understand that pupils need to attend medical appointments during the school day. If your child has an appointment they can be collected from/returned to school via the main entrance.

Absence During Term Time

In accordance with the Trust's Attendance Policy, time off for holidays during term time will not be authorised and a fine/sanctions may be issued by the Local Authority.

Illness

If children are going to be absent from school due to illness. Please inform the school office by telephone or email before 9.10 am.

Every day your child is absent impacts on their education and academic achievement

There is a clear link between attendance and attainment

95% ← Attendance	→ 9 ← Days Absent	> 2 ← Weeks Absent	→ 50 Lessons Missed
90% ← Attendance	→ 19 ← Days Absent	Weeks Absent	→ 100 Lessons Missed
85% ← Attendance	→ 29 ← Days Absent	> 6 Weeks Absent	→ 150 Lessons Missed
80% ← Attendance	\rightarrow 38 \leftarrow Days Absent	> 8 - Weeks Absent	→ 200 Lessons Missed
75% ← Attendance	→ 48 ← Days Absent	> 10 ← Weeks Absent	→ 250 Lessons Missed
70% ← Attendance	\rightarrow 57 \leftarrow Days Absent	> 11.5 ← Weeks Absent	→ 290 Lessons Missed
65% ← Attendance	→ 67 ← Days Absent	> 13.5 < Weeks Absent	→ 340 Lessons Missed


