This weekend some of our children will be receiving their First Holy Communion in a Mass being held in Holy Family Church on Saturday 18th May, 2024 at 10.00 am.

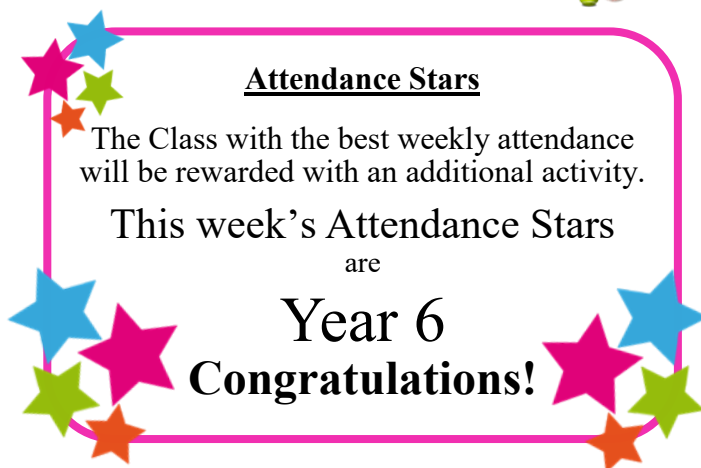
