

Art & Design

Intent:

At Holy Family we want to inspire, engage and challenge pupils by equipping them with the knowledge and skills to experiment and create their own works of art.

- As they progress through our school they will develop a deeper understanding of art and design, exploring the impact it has on the contemporary life and that of different times and cultures.
- We believe that as the children progress in their learning, they should be able to think critically and develop a more rigorous understanding of art and design.
- We believe that children should know how art and design both reflect and shape our history and contribute to the future and creativity around the world.
- Pupils will study at least one artist in depth.
- Pupils will be encouraged to be reflective and evaluate their own work, thinking about how they can make changes and keep improving.
- Children are encouraged to take risks and experiment and then reflect on why some ideas and techniques are successful or not for a particular project.

Implementation:

- The subject leader will provide all staff with an art curriculum framework with planned cross curricular links and specific artists.
- Teaching and Learning will show progression across all key stages within the strands of Art and Design.
- Art will be taught every term, where a particular skill or technique is explored.
- Art will be assessed through termly focussed objectives based on the specific strands of art covered during the term.
- Children will be encouraged to explore the work of artists and use this as inspiration for their own creativity.

How are we developing Cultural Capital?

- Showcase and share artwork around the school and in the local community.
- Visits and visitors to inspire and encourage pupils.
- Art and design homework tasks to encourage pupils to experiment and develop their interest in art.
