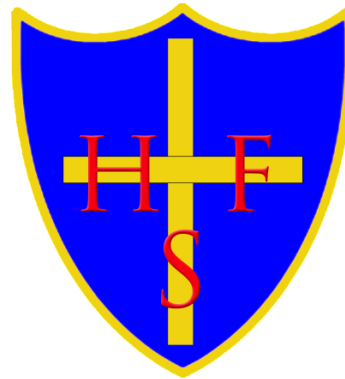


Scenario 1– Individual Absence

This covers an initial short absence (3/4 days) whilst awaiting the outcome of a COVID test (parent or sibling or other close contact). Work will be provided, that is aligned to the year group curriculum and will be uploaded to Class Teams/ Dojo. Parents are to contact school to make us aware of the absence/ that work is needed.

Scenario 2– Self Isolation

This covers any period where a child is required to self-isolate (up to 10 days) due to having been in contact with someone who has tested positive for COVID-19, tested positive themselves or has been contacted by NHS Track & Trace. Work will be provided, directly aligned to what is being taught in class. This will be prepared by the class teacher. Contact school to make us aware that a pack is needed. Teachers will also offer email support or support via the phone or our online platform.



Scenario 3– Bubbles

This covers any period where a school 'bubble' is self-isolating (10 days), due to a confirmed case. Work will be provided, directly aligned to the year group curriculum, via online platforms such as Teams for key stage two children or Class Dojo for KS1 and early years children. Teachers will also offer email/ dojo/ phone support.

Scenario 4—Whole School

This covers any period where the whole school is in lockdown. Work and live lessons will be provided, directly aligned to the year group curriculum, via online platforms for Key Stage Two and KS1 will have a blended approach of work uploaded to Class Dojo with some online lessons. Work packs containing printed daily structured activities will be provided for key stage one children. Exercise books, stationery packs and reading books will also be available. Teachers will also offer email/ phone/ Dojo support.

Scenario 5– Long Term Shielding

This phase covers children who are shielding due to being clinically medically vulnerable or a family member who is clinically medical vulnerable. Class teachers will liaise with families directly to produce a bespoke package of support based around need.
