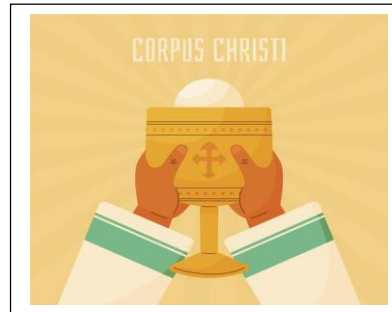
Dear Jesus,
