#### Coronavirus update - important information

#### You must self-isolate immediately if:

- you have any symptoms of coronavirus (a high temperature, a new, continuous cough or a loss or change to your sense of smell or taste)
- you live with someone who has symptoms or tested positive
- someone in your support bubble has symptoms or tested positive

If one person has any of the above symptoms then all the household must self isolate. The person with the symptoms must get tested and isolate for 10 days. The others must isolate for 14 days and only get tested if the show symptoms. Further advice can be found at NHS website or by phoning 119

Please note the following;

- If you, as a parent, feel more comfortable wearing a mask in the school grounds you are welcome to do so, but please still observe social distancing rules while waiting in the playground and speaking to other parents. Please respect other parent/carers whilst on the school site and outside the school premises with social distancing precautions
- Floor stickers will be put in place, please observe these.
- One way system for pick up and drop off, entrance to school is the gate by the staff car park and exit by the gate nearest nursery.
- Parents/Carers must not enter classrooms
- Only one parent/carer to drop off and collect

In order to allow for social distancing at the end of the school day, Key Stage 2 children will wait in designated areas indicated by markings on the Key Stage 2 playground. The areas are as follows:

- Year 3 by the circles
- Year 4 by the wall
- Year 5 by the compass
- Year 6 by the map.
- Unless collecting younger siblings, we would ask Year 6 parents to please wait by the black fence where your child will be able to see you.

The playground equipment has been taped off, until further notice.
