


<p>RE In this topic children will learn about the Mass and the importance of it for us. The children will be looking at the Last Supper and reflecting on the meaning of this. We will be focusing on what happens during Mass. We will then be looking at our Parish Church and recognising the importance.</p>	<p>English Stories with a theme: '101 Dalmatians'. We will be focusing on our use of vocabulary in our writing, creating setting descriptions, incorporating speech and using a range of sentence openers. Children will create a narrative with an innovated plot structure. Poem: 'Roger the Dog' by Ted Hughes. We will be analysed the poem and discussed the meaning of unfamiliar words. We prepared the poem to read aloud using actions.</p>		<p>Maths This term we will look at: <u>Multiplication and Division</u> We will look at multiplying and dividing 2-digit and 1-digit numbers using formal methods. <u>Length and Perimeter</u> We will look at measuring objects in the classroom using cm and mm, finding equivalent lengths, comparing lengths and adding and subtracting lengths. We will be recalling our 2x, 5x and 10x.</p>		
<p>Geography We will be studying the local area. We will explore a range of maps to find features of our local area. We will identify what makes Preston a city and why people may come to visit Preston. We will explore our local area through taking part in fieldwork activities.</p>	 <h2 style="margin: 0;">Spring Term</h2>		<p>Science This term we will be learning all about Plants. We will identify and describe the functions of different parts of flowering plants. We will find out the requirements of plants for life and growth through investigations. We will investigate the way in which water is transported.</p>		
<p>D&T We are going to be considering what makes a healthy and varied diet. We will be investigating a range of food products and carrying out evaluations of different foods. We will be planning the main stages of the recipe and selecting appropriate tools and equipment.</p>	<p>PSHE This module is focused on our different character strengths and that by understanding what they are and then using them as much as possible, we can be at our best! In this context, character strengths refer to those character traits that make us unique.</p>	<p>Reading Please, please, please encourage your child to read every day. You can read to them, listen to them read and talk to them about what you read (whether that's the daily newspaper, instructions etc...) Not only do we want the children to know that books are important, we want them to develop a love of reading. Books are freeing and can take us to other places! When children are confident and fluent readers, they will achieve well by having full access to the curriculum now, and in secondary school.</p>	<p>Music Children will be appraising different music styles. We will be learning about pulse, rhythm and pitch.</p>	<p>P.E We will be looking at exploring movement to create a sequence in dance linking to superheroes. Children will be exploring how to communicate a character and to convey a narrative through their movements.</p>	<p>Computing This term we will look at computing systems. Children will develop their understanding of digital devices, with an initial focus on inputs, processes, and outputs.</p>
