Who is the team?

Mr Heron is Year 5's Class Teacher. Miss Oates will be teaching on Tuesday afternoons.

PE Days ~ Wednesday and Friday. Please make sure your child always has their full PE kit in school. Can you also make sure their PE kit is named - this will hopefully make it easier to return if anything is lost.

Reading ~ Your child should read every night. Pupils who practise their reading regularly at home and answer questions about what they have read, tend to make significant progress.

Spellings ~ The children will learn about spelling strategies linked to expected spellings for each year in primary school - they will learn rules in school and spellings will be sent home as part of homework. We will also be learning about Latin words which are used in the English language.

Homework ~ There is an expectation that your child will read for 10 minutes every night, preferably with someone listening to them.

Times tables ~ these are very important and there are links on our website for your children to play, enjoy and learn their times tables. Recall of times tables facts is crucial for making progress in all areas of maths.

Homework will be given out on a Friday and will be expected to be completed and returned by Thursday. This gives the children time to talk to me on Monday or Tuesday for guidance. Completion of weekly homework is an important part of children becoming responsible for their learning. Children will be expected to complete and hand it in on time throughout their academic career. Children who don't complete homework will complete it in school, during their break time.

I will contact each of you personally, should there be any need to discuss your child's progress. I encourage you to come and see me, should you have any questions or concerns, at the end of the school day.
