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| <p><b>In RE:</b></p> <p>Our topics in R.E. this term are 'The Kingdom of God' and 'Justice'.</p> <p>We will explore some of the kingdom values needed to build God's Kingdom and consider how these values can be incorporated into our own lives today.</p> <p>We will also think deeply about the themes of equality and duty and reflect on how we can promote justice in the world around us.</p>   | <p><b>In English</b></p> <p>There will be independent reading time each day in which children are encouraged to choose a book to read from the school library.</p> <p>Fiction -<br/>This term we will be studying Historical Fiction using the novel 'Viking Boy' by Tony Bradman.</p> <p>We will also be reading and writing suspense fiction, and performing poetry linked to our Viking topic..</p> <p>Non Fiction - We will be reading and sharing texts to celebrate Black History Month in October.</p> |  |   | <p><b>In Maths</b></p> <p>We will be learning about:<br/>Rounding any number up to 10 000 000 to the nearest 10, 100, 1000, 10 000 and 100 000.<br/>Adding and subtracting whole numbers with more than 4 digits and decimals with two decimal places.<br/>We will identify how to multiply and divide numbers using our whole school approach.</p> <p><b>Children will also revise their times tables and quick recall of them.</b></p> |  |  |
| <p><b>Science</b></p> <p>Evolution and Inheritance. We will be looking at how living things have changed over time with fossils providing information about habitation millions of years ago. We will also find out why it is useful that characteristics are passed on from parents to offspring.</p> <p>Our Second Science topic for this term is Living things and their habitats. | <p><b>PE</b></p> <p>Wednesdays and Fridays are our PE session this term. Our themes for this term are orienteering and Hockey. The Hockey sessions will be delivered by coaches from PNE.</p>   | <p><b>Latin</b></p> <p>Children will be making links between Latin and English vocabulary and grammar. We will learn through Minimus Secundus program.</p>  | <p><b>Music</b></p> <p>Children will explore I music linked to our theme of Vikings. They will learn a range of different styles of songs and use percussion instruments</p> | <p><b>PSHE</b></p> <p>We will be learning about safe and unsafe relationships</p> | <p><b>Art/D &amp; T</b></p> <p>The children will be creating a piece of artwork using clay. They will create a Viking head using sculpting techniques. Our DT unit will be food technology with the theme Healthy Soups.</p>   | <p><b>Reading</b></p> <p>Home reading is crucial. Children will choose their own home reading books. We will also be working in class on our guided reading book activities based around our class novel and a range of different texts.</p> |  |
