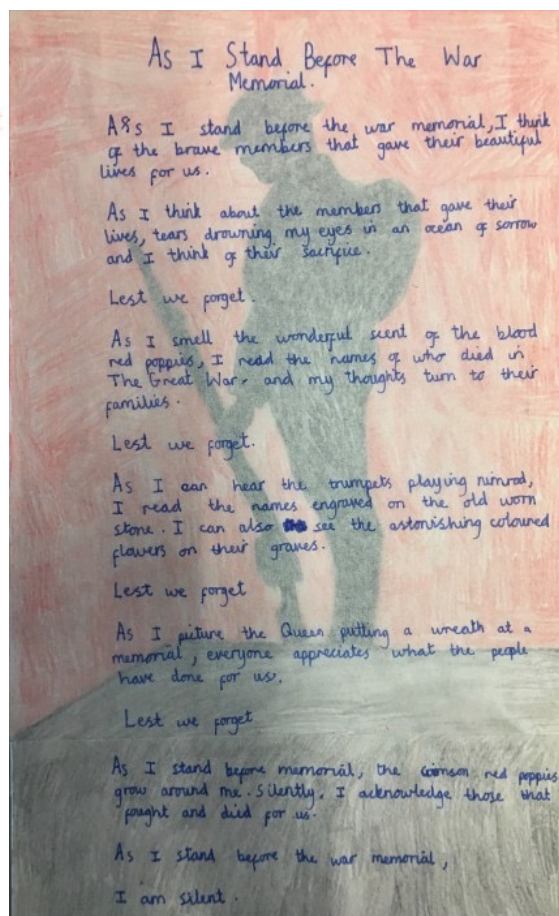




Message from the Headteacher

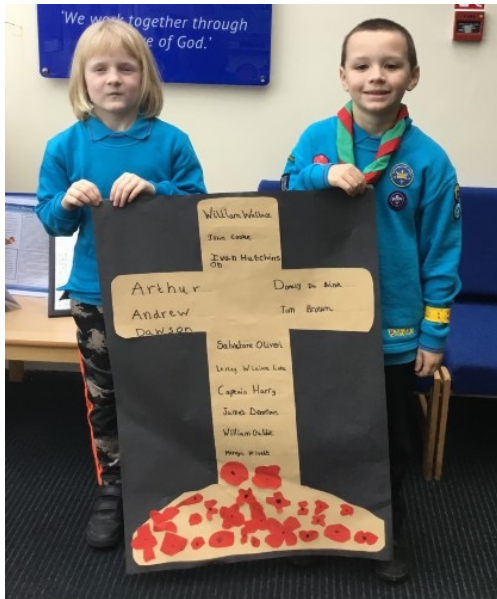

Personal Summary

25th October 1914

Dear Mum and Dad,

I'm writing to tell you what you're bad. Our captain still on should keep on fighting
 but instead of being close we called a truce. I hope we don't have a fight again
 but I suppose the generals are getting on well so we need fighting.

I kicked a football into the street (towards my sleeping place) and the German's
searched in kick's around and we started a match. The German's won 3-2.

I hope you're okay. Has Dad got a sig for yet? If he has, I hope he hasn't been
billed.

Trreally miss home, you, Arthur, Roger, your coast, my soldier, my bed and a nice hot bath. I'll go back without you.

We exchanged prisoners, dated, played cards, decorated the vessels, wrote poems, kept a list such as: *conspirators*.

I'm getting very cold because the windows have no cover. Perhaps you could knit me a thick blanket, Mum.

I've made friends with a German named Robert Saunders. He is so much fun! We are always wild!

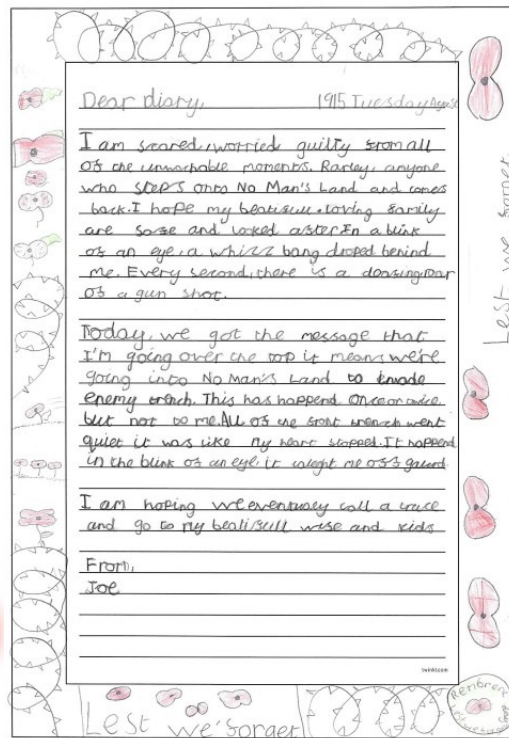
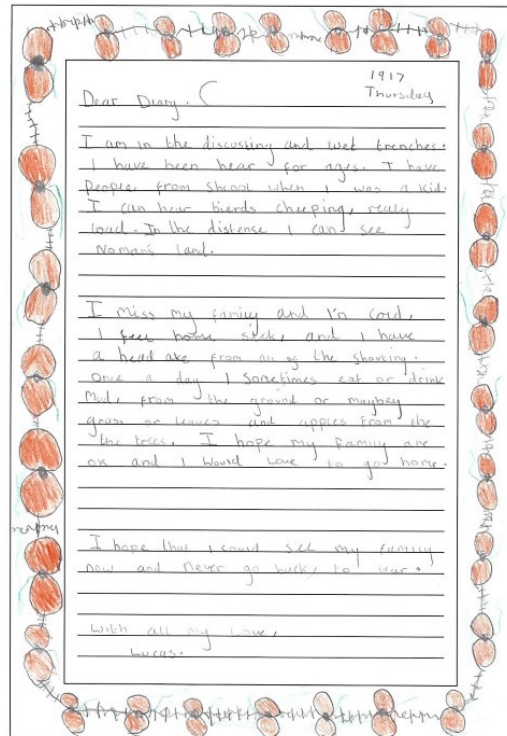
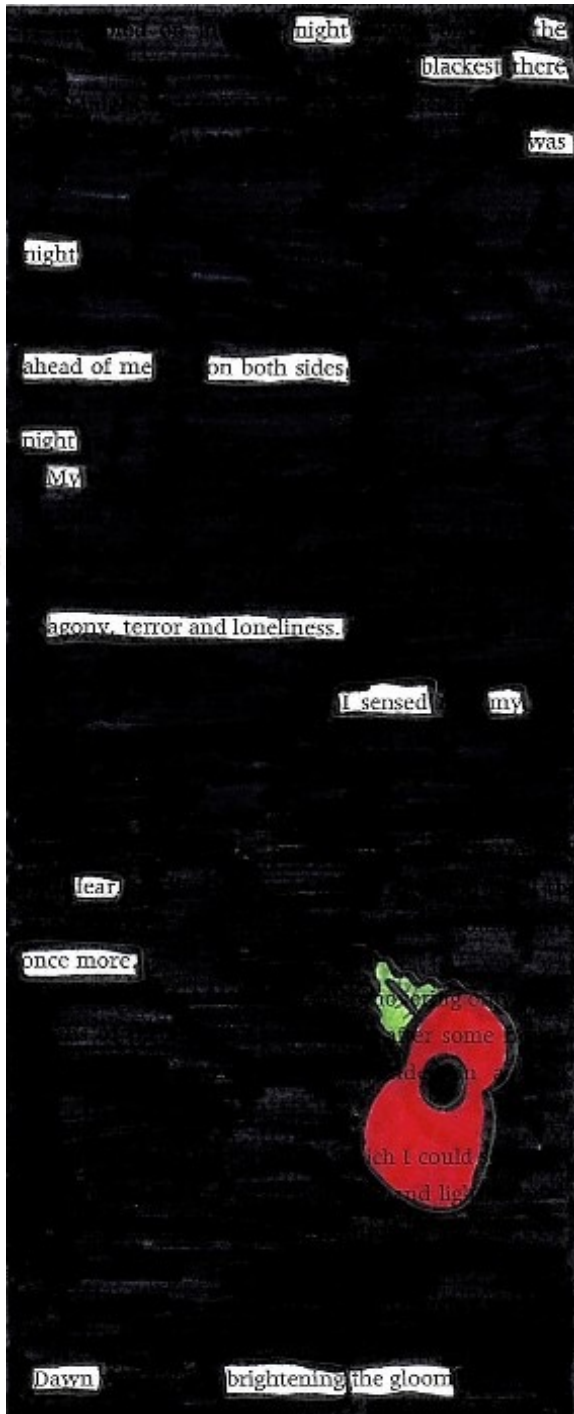
Dear MUM and Dad,
