#### Maths Week England 2020

This week, KS2 have thoroughly enjoyed taking part in the *Times Tables Rock Stars* 'Rock Out' competition in which over 10,000 schools in the country have been competing against each other to answer the most times table questions correctly. At the time of writing, Holy Trinity is placed **57**<sup>th</sup> in the country with an average of **2729** correct answers per child! Putting competition aside, this week has shown a huge increase in the recall and fluency of times tables for those children taking part, demonstrating the importance of continued practise of times tables throughout the year.







Today marks the end of the second week of **Barvember**. This is a **bar modelling** event that is running throughout the whole of November through White Rose Maths, a Maths scheme which many of you will have become familiar with during lockdown learning. Children across KS1 and KS2 have been enjoying learning to use bar models to help them visualise reasoning problems. Teachers have reported a steady increase in the confidence of children to work with greater independence and confidence when faced with multi-step reasoning problems by using the bar modelling approach.
