Message from the Headteacher

On Wednesday, eight children from Year 5 and 6 took part in a Swimming Gala hosted by Four Shires Swimming Club at Chipping Norton Leisure Centre. The children represented the school so well



and were commended for their excellent sportsmanship. The children finished joint 1st with Kingham, only just losing out on overall 1st Place finish by 12 seconds. Despite not winning overall, the children excelled at the Backstroke Relay and All 8 Float Relay finishing ahead of all the schools present.

Also on Wednesday, Year 3 took part in a Dance Workshop hosted by the Year 12 Sports Leaders from CNS. The children started off the afternoon by being introduced to a range of moves inspired by the Disney Film of Despicable Me.

Over the course of the Workshop the children had the opportunity to link their movements to the beat of the music and introduce their own movements which they added into their routines.

To assist with the ever changing rules for isolation, we have been sent through a very useful chart. This is on page 2 and will hopefully help with when to test and the time required to isolate.

Changes to Isolation Periods

The isolation period is still 10 days but can be reduced to **5 full days** (as long as your child is well enough and without a temperature) and receives **2 consecutive negative** LFD results which were **taken 24 hours apart**.

The earliest they should take the first LFD test is on day 5.

Any **positive test** after a first **negative test** would mean that the first negative is **null and void**. This would **reset** the isolation period and your child would still require 2 consecutive negative tests from this point forward. You must register results with the NHS Website [here](#) and you must **e-mail** both those results to school. You can order a pack of LFD tests [here](#).

TO RETURN ON THE DAY OF A SECOND NEGATIVE TEST, BOTH TESTS WOULD NEED TO BE TAKEN BEFORE 9AM.

Anyone who tests positive must isolate for a full 5 days.

Scenario 1 A negative test on Day 5 and then Day 6. Isolation ends on Day 6 once the 2nd LFD test is negative.

Day Zero is the day symptoms started **or** the day the test was taken if asymptomatic. Day 1 of isolation is the day after Day Zero.

In any scenario, the isolation period can only end if your child no longer has a high temperature. This applies even if they have tested negative twice. If children still have a high temperature after Day 10, they should stay off school and seek medical advice such as contacting your GP or phoning 111.
