This week, all the children got to take part in the NSPCC's 'Speak Out, Stay Safe' assemblies. These helped the children recognise signs of abuse, in a child-friendly and age-appropriate way, and know that they should talk to a trusted adult if they feel worried or uncomfortable about anything. All children learned the Childline telephone number: 08001111.

On Tuesday, Margo from Father Hudson Care, visited to tell the children all about the 'Good Shepherd' appeal, raising money during Lent to support vulnerable people. Every child has brought home a collection box to collect donations in.
