Travelling Book Fair Competitions

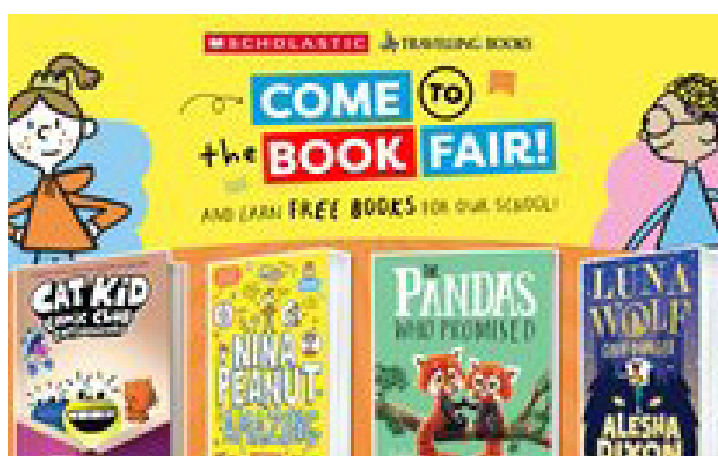

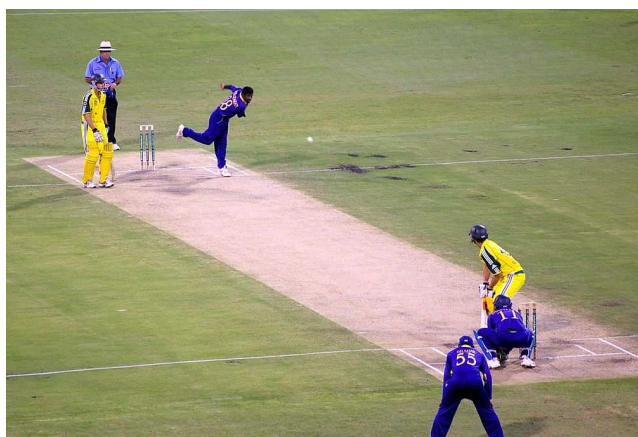
