Due to our outstanding performance the previous week at the Chipping Norton Music Festival, we were the only Junior Choir invited to perform at the closing Festival Concert and Prizegiving evening, where we were awarded the Robin Martin-Oliver trophy. A huge thank you to all the



children who took part and a special thank you goes to Mrs Clay for all her hard work, dedication and time to the Choir.

On Tuesday, the Children of Year 3 and 4 performed their Easter Production retelling the Easter Story from Jesus' entrance into Jerusalem on Palm Sunday through to his Resurrection on Easter Sunday. The children retold the key events of Holy Week and highlighted the importance of
