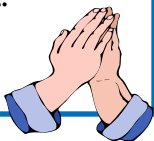
Prayer for June

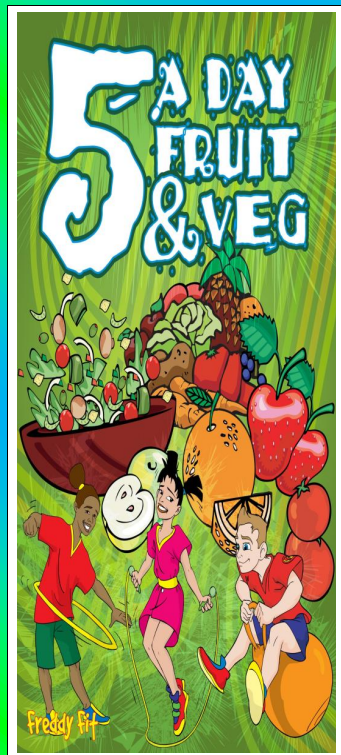
