Message from the Headteacher

Dear Parents,

We have had a number of requests asking if more than one parent can be allowed to attend Sports Day.

At the moment, it is illegal for gatherings of more than 30 people and Sports Day does not come under the Government's definition of 'organised sport'. Spectators must also observe social distancing. I would just like to stress that these are not school rules, but the Government's. Therefore, we can only invite one parent per child to watch Reception, Year 1 and Year 6 Sports Day. We would ask parents to arrange which adult will be attending. You are very welcome to bring a picnic blanket or a chair.

As you will have seen from the last newsletter, the races will be one-hour slots. Younger siblings, unfortunately, cannot come along as they are counted within the 30 spectators.

We know that this is not ideal, but at least this way one parent will be able to see their child's first or last Sports Day. Reception and KS1 children should come in in their PE kits on that day. If we have adverse weather conditions we will send out a Parent Mail on Sunday 6th June and postpone until 10th June. However, the long term forecast is looking favourable.
