



## The Prayer

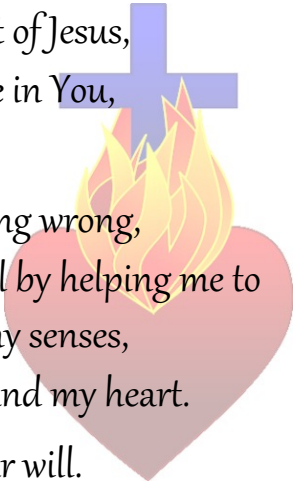
The Month of June is dedicated to the Sacred Heart of Jesus.

## Message from the Headteacher

This week started with Pentecost Sunday, which we celebrated in our Monday collective worship assembly. Pentecost is a celebration of the coming of the Holy Spirit 50 days after Easter. In Mass on Sunday Father shared our children's birthday cards with the congregation as Pentecost is considered the birthday of the Christian church.

On Tuesday, Year 3 took a trip to Ufton Court for an immersive Ancient Egyptian Day. They were part of a Prince's household and learnt about ancient games that were played in that time period. They then took part in the Embalming and Mummification process and re-enacted the ceremony where the children were involved in various aspects such as being the High Priest, the embalmers and the guards. Luckily, the weather was sunny and children enjoyed an outdoor picnic at lunchtime.
