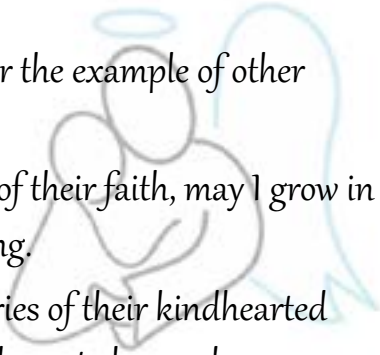
Dear God,
