Urgent – your views on 20mph limits

There is still time to tell Oxfordshire County Council your views on Chippy's proposed 20 mph speed limits, with an extended deadline of 7 December. Oxfordshire County Council is proposing to introduce a 20mph zone in the centre of Chipping Norton. Your views are important as this will affect safety and traffic in the Town. The proposed limit, for what might be a first phase, covers all five main roads out of town, but only as far as the edge of the town centre and stops short of the narrow part of West St, nor along past The Green/ St Mary's School, nor by Holy Trinity School nor by Chipping Norton School. The Town Council are funding the initial scheme and apparently extending the limit past the schools would be more costly and any extension would have to be done later. Because of the short period of notice for the official consultation (deadline was 2 November), OCC have now said they will note all views sent in by 7 December. The comments will be passed onto the Cabinet Member for Environment decisions meeting which has been arranged for 20 December. Members of the public may also apply to OCC to address that meeting.
