Autumn 2 Curriculum

English



We have lots of exciting writing opportunities planned this term, starting with the traditional tale Pinocchio. We then move on to the story, How to Catch Santa by Jean Reagan, where we will be writing character descriptions, letters, instructions and retelling the story. We will also look at a poetry, 'What's in the Christmas Box?'

Maths



Our key topics include: **Year 1 - addition and subtraction, shape and place value and Year 2 - addition and subtraction, money and multiplication and division.** Year 2 can also use *Times Tables Rock Stars* to practise their times tables at home.

cchHistor



Our History topic this half term is called 'My family history'. In this topic the children will be learning about significant historical events, people and places in their own locality. They will look at some of the ways in which we find out about the past and identify different ways in which it is represented (sources - books/pictures/videos/people/experience).

DT	Our DT topic this half term is called 'Perfect Pizzas'. In this topic the children will find out what the favourite pizzas in the class are, examine, describe and categorise a variety of bread-based products, examine, describe and categorise a variety of pizza toppings and design and make a balanced healthy pizza.
Science	Animals including humans – growth and survival. In this topic the children will be identifying the offspring of a variety of animals and learning that animals reproduce in different ways. They will be identifying the stages of a lifecycle and exploring the environment as a factor of survival for animals. They will also be exploring the effect of exercise on the human body and inventing a healthy lunch box.
PSHE	In PSHE, we will explore 'Getting on and falling out' and 'Anti-bullying'.
Computing	For this session we will focus on word processing skills and E safety.
	Our PE session will be delivered by Mr Challinor and will focus on manipulative and functional skills.
Religious Education	Incarnation In this topic the childre will be finding out – Why does Christmas matter to Christians? They will be learning about the Christmas story and exploring that Christians believe that Jesus was the Son of God.
