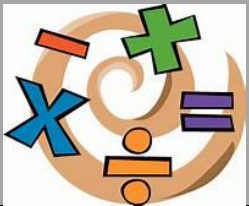
Autumn 2 Curriculum

English



We have lots of exciting writing opportunities planned this term, starting with our 'Poetry Week' where we will be performing and writing senses poems. We will then be basing our work around the book *'The Bear and the Piano'*. We will be writing descriptions, letters, wanted posters, and stories. Year 1 will be focusing on sentence construction, using a capital letters and a full stops, whilst Year 2 will be focusing on using adjectives and expanded noun phrases to describe, conjunctions and question marks. We will then move onto our Christmas story *'Moz the Monster'* where we will be writing descriptions, diary entries, stories and instructions.

Maths









Our focus points this term will be **Big Maths**. The children will undertake these tests every Monday. Other key topics include **place value, multiplication and division, money and time**. Year 2 can also use **Times Tables Rock Stars** to practise their times tables at home.

History



'My Family' The children will be looking at history within living memory by focusing on the history of their family and producing a simple family tree.
