English

Maths

We will continue with our Big Maths every Friday, children may bring these sheets home to look at mistakes or practice individual areas. We will be continuing to push our work on times tables and the use of Times Tables Rock stars to ensure we are fluent in all tables up to x 12.

History

Science



Our focus this term is Electricity

We will be covering the below National Curriculum objectives:

- identify common appliances that run on electricity
- construct a simple series electrical circuit, identifying and naming its basic parts, including cells, wires, bulbs, switches and buzzers
- ♣ identify whether or not a lamp will light in a simple series circuit, based on whether or not the lamp is part of a complete loop with a battery
- * recognise that a switch opens and closes a circuit and associate this with whether or not a lamp lights in a simple series circuit
- * recognise some common conductors and insulators, and associate metals with being good conductors.
