- Bottles must be taken home at the end of the day to be washed and refilled for the next day






Behaviour



Behaviour system- Good to be Green

A colour-coded chart is displayed in every classroom as a visual reminder. Pupils will be able to move their names/pictures accordingly. However, every session, all pupils start on 'Green'.



Our expectation is that every child will remain on the green all day. This will result in an additional 2 Dojos being awarded per week. Alongside this, Dojos will be given for other positive behaviours (see dojo chart below).

For exemplary behaviour and achievements, a Superstar Dojo will be awarded (+2 points) and a raffle ticket for the Headteacher's award will go into a weekly draw.

Dojo certificates, awarded for interval steps of 50, will be presented in Achievement assembly.



Dojo awards- parent and teacher view:







Poor Choices




For repeated negative behaviour, the following steps will be taken:

- Yellow 0 points deducted and a warning.
- Orange 1 point deducted and 5 minutes 'loss of Golden Time' (Y2-Y6) or 'Time Out' (REC-Y1).
- Red –2 points deducted and further consequences to be decided by the headteacher.







A note will be added to the Dojo system so that parents will understand why the pupil has received a negative Dojo. For more serious incidents (Red Dojos), parents will be informed via a phone call or face-to-face discussion with the headteacher or class teacher.

All Dojos are instantly accessible to parents via the ClassDojo app or link via email from your child's class teacher.

Homework

Homework is used to enhance and support the learning which takes place in school; it should not be a chore or battle. Little and often is the best way.

Weekly Homework

- Reading daily please record this in the reading diaries.
- Learning weekly spellings and practising the Year 5 and 6 words
- Learning multiplication tables

There may be additional homework which may take the form of research or investigation, or if a child needs more practice in maths and English. However, this will be on a needs basis.

Pupils should use Spelling Shed to practise their weekly spellings in a fun, interactive way. However, it is still important to practise writing them down and putting them in sentences as this helps with vocabulary and muscle memory.

Multiplication tables are the key for all areas of maths. As a school, we use the Times Tables Rock Stars programme. All the pupils have a login and can access this at any time. The children have completed a baseline test which has assigned them to the appropriate table to practise. This automatically moves with them as they improve or need support.
