If you have to drive, you can still help greatly by making sure you park or drop off away from the school gate, in a legal, safe and considerate way. This leaflet aims to offer you alternative areas of the village for safe parking.

AVAILABLE PARKING PLACES

The Crown, The Square



Management of The Crown will allow short term parking subject to the following conditions:

Patrons of the pub have priority parking.

Park responsibly and be mindful of other users.

Give way to children and pedestrians.

Parking is at owners' risk. Management will not accept liability for accidental damage or loss incurred.



The Picnic Area, Shrubberies (Approx 4 min walk)

This is for all public parking so may be occupied by others on occasions.

Sensible parking should accommodate up to 8 cars. (4 on each side).



Church Road (Approx 2 min walk)

Kerbside – Public parking

CAUTION Heavy agricultural vehicles passing.

Please avoid parking opposite the exit from Victoria Meadow and make sure children are kept on the footpath at all times.



Village Hall, Church Road

Private Car Park – Permission has been granted by special arrangement and is subject to the following conditions:

Parking is available only between

8.35 - 8.55 am. And 3.05 -3.25 pm.

Patrons of the village hall have priority so please adhere to these strict time limits to avoid this facility being withdrawn.

The Beck (approx. 2 mins)



Kerbside – Public parking.

Use the public path alongside Elizabeth Grove which will take you directly to the school gates.



Church Avenue (approx. 2.5 Mins)



Permission has been granted for parking in Church Avenue under the following conditions:

When exiting, please follow the road round to the right and drive down Church Road. i.e. no turning round in The Avenue.

Please don't park on grass verges.

Visitors to the Church have priority at all times.

Please do not leave litter in the Avenue.

For access to school, either

1. Walk down Church Road and turn left into a small path leading to The Square or 2. Walk to the village playground and continue walking until reaching The Square and school gate.

You might also consider:

- *Offer to walk a friend in to school with your child. Adopt a 'walking buddies' culture.*
- *Walk from further sites – Increases 'steps' and encourages healthy habits.*

- *Car share with your neighbours.*
- *Stagger drop off times*
- *Make sure children exit the car on the side next to the pavement.*
- *Please don't hog the parking spaces, move on as soon as you can so someone else can park*
