
## Summer 1 Curriculum

### English




We will begin the Summer term by looking at the wonderful book entitled 'The Iron Man' by Ted Hughes. The focus will be for the children to write their own story using all the fantastic tools for writing they have practised all year. To finish the half term, we will be looking at explanation texts and reading the book 'Until I met Dudley' by Roger McGough. This book is a wonderful blend of non-fiction and fiction that explains how things work.

### Maths



Our key topic this term is Time. Year 4s are expected to take a multiplication tables check in June, so it is imperative that they can rapidly recall their multiplication facts to 12x12. Remember to use **Times Tables Rock Stars** at home.



Our topic this term is Towns and Cities. At the end of the topic, we will be able to understand key aspects of geography in towns and cities. The children will be able to identify key features from towns and cities in the UK.

<p><b>ART</b></p> 	<p>In Art, we will be exploring painting and looking at various techniques to create different looks.</p>
<p><b>Science</b></p> 	<p>We will be exploring the interesting topic of plants. We will look at how to be scientists with investigations, comparing and contrasting and grouping.</p>
 <p><b>PSHE</b></p>	<p>In PSHE, we will be looking at Safety and completing activities to support learning. We will also be looking at ‘<b>Votes For Schools</b>’. Throughout the Spring term there will be opportunities to practice Mindfulness with colouring activities and focused breathing sessions.</p>
<p><b>Computing</b></p> 	<p>In computing, we will be learning word processing skills. We will enhance other areas of the curriculum by producing posters, letters, leaflets etc. which will be designed for specific audiences and purposes.</p>
 <p><b>P.E.</b></p>	<p>This term will be learning about golf and cricket. The children will be learning and practising skills in both of these sports.</p>
<p><b>Religious Education</b></p>	<p>Our RE topic is ‘What I can learn from a Mosque?’ . We will be exploring all the items that can be found in a mosque and any similarities and differences to other religions.</p>
