December	Snowmen cheese sticks, frosty popcorn cups and cheesy reindeer crackers – available on alternative weeks throughout December.


## What the classes have done this week

Class 1: Class 1 have had another busy week. Reception have been looking at length in Maths and Year 1 have started to look at place value within 20. In English, Reception have been practicing reading and writing CVC words and have been working hard on their letter formation in order to develop a cursive script. Year 1 have begun to read and explore information texts. Well done all of you.

**Class 2:** This week, we have been learning all about owls in English. We have been researching using non-fiction texts and writing quizzes. In Maths, we have been learning about money. We have converted pounds and pence; counted in pounds and pence; and selected the correct coins to make a value.

Class 3: This week in Class 3, we have produced some fantastic war poetry based around classic poems. We have also written diary entries as if we were the soldiers going away. In Year 4, we have been using the Waitrose advert, 'Coming Home', in order to inspire our descriptive writing.

In History we have investigated the Bass family and their links to brewing in Burton. In science we have completed several parachute investigations based around air resistance - we have changed the length of the parachute strings, the size of the parachute and the material of the parachute and considered the best recommendations for making a parachute.
