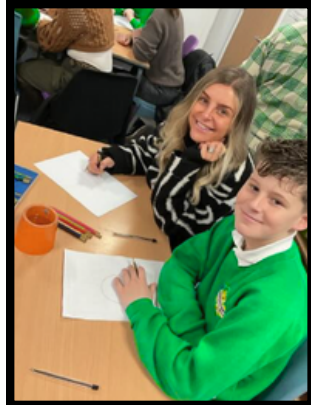




Communication
