Safer Internet Day

On the 10th February, the whole school continued to develop their understanding of how to stay safe online. There was an assembly led by Mrs Wood, our Computing Lead and Turtle class plus different activities throughout the day to ensure children know how and why it is important to stay safe online, with a particular focus on Artificial Intelligence.

Whales class had a Safer Internet Day with a visit from a Metropolitan Police Officer who came to talk to the children all about how to stay safe online. We also looked at deepfake videos, and were detectives to determine which were real or fake.
