

What we are learning:


The topic for this half term is a DT focused topic. The children will be looking at different materials, techniques and learn the skills to make a hand puppet. The techniques children will be learning are how to cut fabric, how to sew these together using a running stitch.

Science


The topic for this term is forces. The children will learn how to recognise and name pushes and pulls. They will also learn how things move in certain directions and about an important scientist - Isaac Newton.

Literacy

In Literacy, your child will be looking at fairytales. The children will be writing a narrative. They will use their own ideas and imagination to be able to create their own fairytale. We will also be reading the story of 'The Last Wolf'.




Design Technology - How can we bring traditional toys to life? Key Stage 2



RE

In RE, your child will look at Community - Islam Living. They will learn about Muslim practises such as worship and festivals.



Physical, Emotional Health and Well Being.

The topic this term is Healthy Me. The children will understand what foods are healthy and the importance of exercise.

PE

In PE, the children will focus on Basketball. They will be looking at ball control, learning how to dribble correctly as well as passing and moving the ball.

Maths

In Maths, your child will be learning place value. The Year 1's will learn more about shape and start to understand fractions as well as revisiting and deepening knowledge of place value to 100. Year 2's will develop their knowledge of shape and fractions, by finding halves, quarters, and thirds of shapes, numbers and amounts. They will also learn how to read pictograms and charts.

Home Learning Opportunities:

Home reading is essential to developing your child's reading. Please encourage your child to take part in the 10 minutes a day reading challenge. A recent study found that those children who read at least 5 times a week for 10 minutes are those who achieve the highest standards at the end of Key Stage 2.
