Parking

Uniform

We are aware that children can struggle to concentrate if they are hungry. If your child is in KS2 and you want to send them with a healthy snack such as fruit, raisins or a cereal bar to eat at playtime. Please make sure these do not contain nuts; **we are a nut free school.**

The children in KS1 are already provided with fruit through a government funded scheme.

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Allergies

You may be aware that Benedict's Law, a law which means schools have to implement new allergy safety measures, comes into force at the start of this school year. We want to reassure you all staff in school have completed the necessary training to ensure all children are safe. One of our pupils in Early Years does have a severe allergy to milk, please avoid bring milk based products into the Early Years unit and follow our processes for sanitising hands when entering the building – thank you for your support with this.
