Personal development

As part of the Personal Development curriculum, Reception visited Twist and Flip and took part in some gymnastic activities. This helped to develop resilience and sports skills as well as their understanding of healthy and safe behaviours.

Children have continued to represent the school at different sporting events such as football, swimming, kurling and cricket. These opportunities help the children to develop their skills to work effectively as part of a team and demonstrate respect towards adults and children who they don't work with on a regular basis.

Transition

Due to the success of our early transition last year, we are organising something similar this year. All children will move to their new class on Monday 15th of July and will stay there until the end of the term.

The main reason for doing this is that we want to eliminate anxieties with transition that some children feel over the summer holidays. This way they will have met their teacher and be settled into the class ready for September. The teacher also gets to know the children well before the summer break so planning and preparation can be done based on a secure knowledge of the class and the needs of the children.

The current Y6 will be referred to as Y7 during this time and will have additional activities to finish off their time at Cloverfields. This will include Mini Medics First Aid, sporting events and a visit to the Eco-Centre.
