### Communication and Language

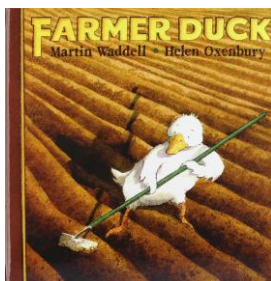

During the term, the children will learn that nature changes over time with a particular focus on Spring.

### Maths

The children will be representing and comparing numbers 9 and 10. Children will become more familiar with tens frames. They will continue learning to double and begin to learn number bonds to 5 and 10. They will explore 3D shapes.

### PSED

The children will be developing their confidence when talking about their own personal experiences of being fit and healthy. They will be learning how to make sensible food choices and how to keep themselves active.

### Expressive Arts and Design

The creation station will be set up with materials to encourage children to make their own models. They will be taught fixing and cutting techniques. They will continue to learn colour mixing techniques. Their creations will be valued.

### Literacy

We will be reading the books Farmer Duck and Mucky Duck. The children will celebrate reading through World Book Day on Thursday 5<sup>th</sup> March.

The children will continue to follow the Monster Phonics Programme. They will be learning to write words, captions and simple sentences. They will be learning to read new focus words.
