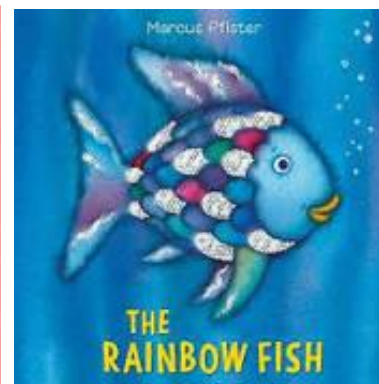
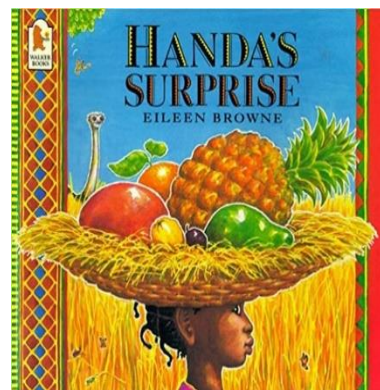

Enquiry Question: What can I tell you about where I live?

Key Questions

1. How is Handa's house different to ours?
2. How can we be a good friend?
3. What is a map used for?
4. Why is it not sunny every day?



Maths

They will learn to represent and compare the numbers 1, 2 and 3. They will match and sort items and compare different amounts, extending their mathematical language. The children will continue to learn number songs and nursery rhymes to support their learning in Maths.

PSED

The children we be settling into the daily school routine to build their independence up. They will will begin to make new friends and be given time to talk about their experiences with adults and peers. Teaching staff will be getting know children and will build relationships with them.

Expressive Arts and Design

The craft area will be set up with materials to encourage children make their very own homes. They will learn new nursery rhymes and simple songs. Children will begin to mix different paint colours.

Literacy

We will be reading the books the Rainbow Fish and Handa's surprise. The children will learn new vocabulary whilst exploring the stories and the knowledge extracted from the text.

The children will begin to bring home a reading book that links with the Phonics Programme Monster Phonics. They will be required to say the sound of the graphemes they have learnt.
