Understanding of the World

Science:

This term we are learning about Animals and Living Things with a specific focus on animals and their offspring and their needs to flourish and survive. We will also be looking at humans and how eating healthily and regular exercise helps maintain a healthy balanced person. Alongside this, we will be looking at how to meet humans basic needs. We will be looking at scientific careers such as: vet, Zoologist and Aquatic Zoologist.

What we are learning:

The topic for this half term is 'Our Place in the World'. We will be looking at Cleethorpes and how humans have made their mark on Cleethorpes. As part of our transition to this curriculum we will also be learning about London as the capital city.
