

Art

This term, we are looking at the famous artist Lowry. The children will learn how to colour mix and draw people using shapes. They will produce a piece of artwork inspired by Lowry with their chosen transport as a feature.

What we are learning:

The topic for this half term is a history-based topic - 'Which mode of transport would you travel on and why?' KS1 will learn about 3 significant people - Thomas Andrews, The Wright Brothers and Amy Johnson. They will also be learning key facts about Hull.

Literacy

In Literacy, your child will be reading the story 'Emma Janes Aeroplane' and 'Samsons Titanic Journey'. They will learn the features of a non-chronological report and write one about a specific location. The children will use their prior knowledge and current learning to do. The children will learn the key features on how to write a piece of non-fiction.

RE

In RE, your child will reflect on their beliefs and learn what takes place in Christian communities. They will learn about religious festivals and worship.

Science

This term in Science, the children are learning about plants. They will be learning the parts of a plant and looking at different types of trees. The children will understand why some trees lose their leaves and some do not and what is so special about plants.

Maths

In Maths, your child will continue learning addition and subtraction. In Year 2, they will add and subtract numbers to 100, whereas Year 1's will add numbers to 20. Part of this learning will include recognising money. Multiplication and division will then be introduced.

Home Learning Opportunities:

Home reading is essential to developing your child's reading. Please encourage your child to take part in the 10 minutes a day reading challenge. A recent study found that those children who read at least 5 times a week for 10 minutes are those who achieve the highest standards at the end of Key Stage 2

Please count in 2's, 3's, 5's and 10's with you child.

PE

The children will be looking at indoor athletics. They will look at different events that they might see in competitions. The children will learn different skills - running, jumping and throwing.

Physical, Emotional Health and Well Being.

The topic this term is about celebrating differences. The children will learn how they are different from one another and how to accept this.

This term, we will continue learning about online safety and information technology. The year 1's will learn how to use the camera and organise digital content. The year 2's will learn how to organise and collect data.
