Understanding the World

Children will be talking about their families. They will learn about where they live and the different types of houses that they live in. They will be learning about different occupations and the people who help them in our community.

Physical Development

Teaching staff will be encouraging the children to use and remember sequences and patterns of movement which are related to music and rhythm. They will be learning about their bodies and naming the different parts.

Communication and Language

As always, learning areas within the classroom will be designed to encourage children to talk to each other and ask questions. Teaching staff will model and introduce new vocabulary to children. During the topic Our Place in the World, children will be encouraged to talk about themselves, their home and the country they live in.


Parent Map Foundation Stage

Maths

Children will continue to learn number songs and nursery rhymes to support their learning in Maths. The children will learn colours, matching and sorting and be introduced to numbers 1 and 2.

PSED

Children we be settling back into the daily school routine to build their independence up. Children will begin to make new friends and be given time to talk about their experiences with adults and peers. Teaching staff will be getting know children and will develop relationships with them.

Expressive Arts and Design

The craft area will be set up with materials to encourage children to make their own houses. Children will create self-portraits.

They will learn how to colour mix.

Literacy

Children will start to listen to longer stories and remember much of what happens. They will begin to use a wider vocabulary. Children will be reading the book Everywhere Bear and The Big Book of Families. They will talk about the characters of the story and learn about sharing and being kind. Children will receive a book to share at home.
