



PARKING

Dear parents/carers

You may be aware of a serious incident in our car park yesterday morning that resulted in three cars being damaged – at least one possibly written off. We are thankful that no-one – especially a child - was injured.

As you can imagine, this has caused us huge concern and we need to make immediate changes for the safety of all concerned.

From today,

- Some of our staff will not be using the front car park to allow more space
- There will be no access to parents dropping off in the morning between half 8 and 9am unless in receipt of a Blue Badge
- Parents with a Blue Badge must use the designated Disabled space only, if this is occupied, please wait.
- If using the Disabled space, please drop off and return to your car and leave the car park in a timely manner to ensure others can use it
- If you need to pick up or drop off your child during the day at any point, you may use the car park as normal, using the barrier intercom to communicate with the admin team

NOTE:

- If you are walking to the school office, please always use the path and don't cut across the car park – please also talk to your children about this.
- Drive very slowly when entering the car park at any point – it is a busy area

We are in the process of re-designing the space we have to ensure it can be used safely. Please come and speak to me should you have any concerns.

If you use the Humberston Academy entrance to drop off and pick up, please be mindful not to block access to their site.

Parking at Cloverfields is a tricky issue all round but if we work together, we can make sure it is safe as well as being convenient for all.
