## Understanding the World

Children will begin to make comparisons between events in the past and in the present. They will learn about how they have changed from a baby to now and how they will alter as they grow older. They will learn how they go to school in the village Humberston and what types of houses, shops and amenities there are.

## P.E

In PE the children will play lots of turn taking games. They will be developing their spatial awareness. PE is on a Tuesday with Mr Atkinson

## Communication and Language

As always, learning areas within the classroom will be designed to encourage children to talk to each other and ask questions. Teaching staff will model and introduce new vocabulary to children. During the Best of British topic, children will learn vocabulary linked to the seasons, family and the location of Humberston.

## Maths

The children will be representing and comparing numbers 6,7 and 8. They will be matching and sorting items and comparing different weights and capacities. The children will become more familiar with tens frames. They will learn doubling and begin to learn number bonds to 5 and 10.

### **PSED**

The children will be developing their confidence when talking about their own personal experiences with adults and peers. They will be learning how to challenge themselves and make improvements with things they are learning at school and at home.

# Expressive Arts and Design

The creation station will be set up with materials to encourage the children to make their own models. They will be taught fixing and cutting techniques. They will continue to learn colour mixing techniques. Their creations will be valued.

## Literacy

Reception will be reading the books Cinderella and The Kings Pants. Children will learn new vocabulary whilst exploring the stories and the knowledge extracted from the text.

The children will continue to follow the Monster Phonics Programme. They will be learning ow, ee, ur and will be able to write words and simple captions using these sounds.
