

### Understanding the World

### Communication and Language

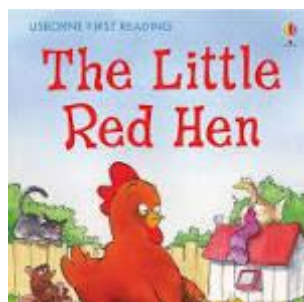
Learning areas within the classroom will be designed to encourage children to talk to each other and ask questions. Teaching staff will model and introduce new vocabulary to children. During the term children will learn the importance of listening and responding appropriately to their friends in partner talk. Sentence extensions will be encouraged through the use of connectives.

### Maths

The children will be representing and comparing numbers 9 and 10. They will become more familiar with numbers beyond 10. They will be able to say one more and one less than a given number. They will continue learning to double and become more secure in recalling number bonds to 5 and 10.

### PSED

The children will be developing their confidence when talking about their own families. They will explore their feelings and how to regulate themselves. They will discuss what makes a good friend and how to be kind to others.

### Expressive Arts and Design

The creation station will be set up with materials to encourage children to make their own treasures. They will implement all fixing and cutting techniques they have learnt this year. They will label, display and evaluate their creations.

### Literacy

We will be reading the books Little Red Hen and Luna Loves Art.

The children will continue to follow the Monster Phonics Programme. They will be learning to write words, captions and simple sentences. They will be learning to read new focus words. They will increase their fluency and be able to talk about the text they are reading.
