## PE Kit Trial

We are looking forward to seeing our **Upper School and Middle School arrive in their school PE kits this Wednesday and Friday.**

We are going to trial a new system at school, for the rest of the summer term we would like **Upper School and Middle School** children to come to school wearing their PE kits on PE days (Wednesdays and Fridays). Lesson time is wasted each week through children finding, re-returning and changing to and from their kits. We calculate that our pupils will gain an extra 20 minutes of learning a week through this initiative, with some children gaining an extra 40 minutes of learning time through not changing their clothes. I am sure you will agree that this is a vast amount of time which we can use in a much more lesson orientated way, please be assured that this is something quite a few schools are now doing. The governors will review the impact of this at their meeting at the end of this term and will take into consideration parental comments so do let school know how you feel the trial is going. If the impact of this is measurably positive it will become a permanent arrangement and we will consider rolling it over to the Lower School class too.

**Middle and Upper School children should therefore attend school on Wednesdays and Fridays wearing dark green or black plain jogging bottoms** (these should **not** have fashionable labels on) **with plain white or black shorts underneath.** If it is going to be a reliably warm day children may just come in the shorts. On their top halves children should wear a **white T shirt with our school crested jumper or cardigan on top. Trainers should be worn on their feet with a pair of pumps in their school bag** if there is a possibility of the weather meaning that the afternoon PE lesson will take place in our school hall. If pumps are not brought the child will do indoor PE barefooted. If your child does not have any of these items they may attend in usual school uniform and we will provide them with one of our spare PE kits for the lesson. If children come to school wearing PE clothes which are not as described above they will given correct PE kit items from school to wear. Thank you very much for your support in this matter.

### Bravery v. Slavery

Harriet Tubman was born nearly 200 years ago in Maryland, USA. Her family were slaves which means that they had to work for the people who 'owned' them. Slaves had no pay and no rights and they could be bought or sold like property. As Harriet grew older she was afraid that she would be sold and sent far away from her family to work for strangers. She decided to try to escape. This needed great **courage** because Harriet knew that if she was caught she would be cruelly punished. After many adventures and with the help of kind people along the way, Harriet managed to escape to Canada, where slavery was banned.

It would have been safest for Harriet to stay in Canada and make for herself a comfortable and easier life, but she was determined not to forget her family and friends who still suffered as slaves in America. She made her way back and forth to Maryland not once, but *nineteen times*, facing great danger and showing amazing bravery as she helped slaves to escape to freedom. By the end of her life Harriet had helped to free around 300 slaves!

After her death Harriet received many honours for her bravery. A ship was named after her, and in 1995 the US government issued a postage stamp to celebrate her **courageous** life.
