The years 5 and 6 children walked down to church today to take part in the Armistice Day service laying wreaths and placing crosses at the graves who fought in the world war.

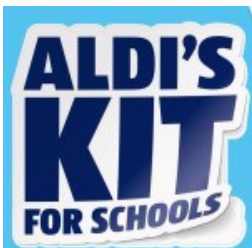


School Photographs

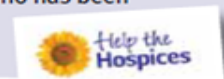
