PE School Kit Days

Following a very positive response, the governors have decided to make permanent our trial of pupils coming to school on PE days in their full PE kit and extend this to our Lower School class too. You will be informed before we return to school in September on which days your child will have PE.

On PE days pupils should come to school wearing dark green or black plain jogging bottoms (these should not have fashionable labels on) with plain white or black shorts underneath. If it going to be a reliably warm day children may just come in their shorts. On their top halves children should wear a white T shirt with our school crested jumper or cardigan on top. Trainers should be worn on their feet with a pair of pumps in their school bag if there is a change in the weather meaning that the afternoon PE lesson will take place in our school hall. If pumps are not brought the child will do indoor PE barefooted. If your child does not have any of these items they may attend in usual school uniform and we will provide them with one of our spare PE kits for the lesson. If children come to school wearing PE clothes which are not as described above they will given correct PE kit items from school to wear.

COVID-19

Please do not send your child in to school if they or members of your household have coronavirus symptoms or have tested positive in the last 10 days.

Symptoms are

- A high temperature—this means you feel hot to the touch on your chest or back (you do not need to measure your temperature)
- A new, continuous cough—this means coughing a lot more than an hour, or 3 or more coughing episodes in 24 hours (if you usually have a cough, it may be worse than usual)
- A loss or change to your sense of smell or taste—this means you've noticed you cannot smell or taste anything, or things smell or taste different to normal
