Please could all parents make sure that they have emailed Mrs Dalton if your child wishes to have milk and/or toast. Unfortunately if no response is received by a parent we will assume that your child does not want it. Thank you.

### Financial Help

We recognise that during this and upcoming financial crisis many lives are altering. If you find that you are claiming any of the benefits below, your school aged child/ren will qualify for **free school dinners and other financial help to help their education within school.**



The range of benefits which qualify you are:

- **Universal Credit** with a household income of less than £7,400 a year (after tax and not including any benefits you get)
- **Income-Based Jobseekers' Allowance**
- **Income-Related Employment and Support Allowance**
- **Child Tax Credit**, not entitled to Working Tax Credit and household income less than £16,190
- **Support under part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999**
- **Guarantee element of State Pension Credit**
- **Income Support**
- **Working Tax Credit 'run on'** – the payment you receive for a further four weeks after you finish work.
