# Financial Help

We recognise that during this pandemic many lives are altering. If you find that you are now claiming any of the benefits below, your school aged child/ren will qualify for free school dinners and other financial help to help their education within school.

The range of benefits which qualify you are:

- **Income Support** .
- Income-based Jobseeker's Allowance .
- Income-related Employment and Support Allowance
- Child Tax Credit, not entitled to Working Tax Credit and household income less than £16,190

Universal Credit with a household income of less than £7,400 a year (after tax and not including any benefits you get)

- Support under Part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999
- Guarantee element of State Pension Credit
- Working Tax Credit 'run on' the payment you receive for a further four weeks after you finish work

# Morrisons It's Good To Grow Vouchers

# <u>COVID-19</u>

Last Friday you received an email with all the procedures we have in place for our school regarding COVID-19. If your child cannot come into school please contact school on the office number. Thank you.

# <u>COVID-19</u>

Please do not send your child in to school if they or members of your household have coronavirus symptoms or have tested positive in the last 10 days.

Symptoms are

- A high temperature—this means you feel hot to the touch on your chest or back (you do not need to measure your temperature)
- A new, continuous cough—this means coughing a lot more than an hour, or 3 or more coughing episodes in 24 hours (if you usually have a cough, it may be worse than usual)
- A loss or change to your sense of smell or taste—this means you've noticed you cannot smell or taste anything, or things smell or taste different to normal

If your child shows any of these symptoms at school we will ring you immediately and expect you to come and collect your child.
