**Your timeslot will be confirmed this week.** We will do our best to accommodate but these will be allocated on a first come first served basis! Thank you.

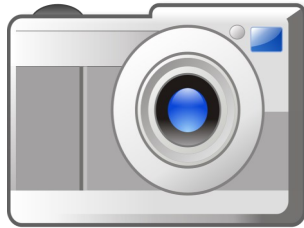
### School Photographs
