Breakfast Club

Our Breakfast Club is held every morning from 8am and pupils may be dropped off at any time from then until classes start at 8.50am. Children must be brought to the main school doors where their parent or carer must sign them in as they hand them over to the member of staff. We provide a range of breakfast items and drinks for our children and they enjoy partaking in numerous activities including games, construction and artwork. **Sessions cost £3.50 per child with household siblings attending the same session costing £2.50.** Payment can be made via the school ParentPay system. **Sessions must be booked in advance.**

New Winter Lunch Menu

Our new Winter lunch menu has started this week. We follow Lancashire Catering Group's weekly menu for primary schools which we publish on our website.

We are very lucky in having Mrs Billington as our catering manager, she always listens to children's comments, quickly learning their likes and dislikes and providing extra choices where necessary, she never leaves a child hungry! The children sit in groups to eat and each table has a large dish full of sliced peppers, cucumber, celery, beetroot, cherry tomatoes, raisins, bread and coleslaw to which the children can help themselves during their meal. Fresh fruit and yogurt are available at each lunchtime as an alternative to the daily dessert and there is always a choice of either water or milk to drink.

If your child usually has packed lunches but you would like your child to have a warm meal during these cold winter months please take a look at the [menu](#) with your child and talk about the options. A school meal costs £2.50 and can be paid through Parentpay. We do have some children who choose to have a packed lunch on some days and a school lunch on others just because they love Mrs Billington's meals.
