## Clubs

### Breakfast Club

Our Breakfast Club is held every morning from 8am and pupils may be dropped off at any time from then until classes start at 8.50am. Children must be brought to the main school doors where their parent or carer must sign them in as they hand them over to the member of staff. We provide a range of breakfast items and drinks for our children and they enjoy partaking in numerous activities including games, construction and artwork. **Sessions cost £3.50 per child with household siblings attending the same session costing £2.50.** payment can be made via the school ParentPay system, childcare vouchers or tax-free childcare scheme. **Sessions must be booked in advance.**

We have a busy timetable of after school clubs running straight through from the end of class time till 4.30pm each day. **Sessions must be booked in advance.**

## PE

Do remember that children should attend school wearing PE kit on their PE days, below is a breakdown of each classes PE days. Please contact the school office if you have any queries about this.

On PE days pupils should come to school wearing **dark green or black plain jogging bottoms** (these should **not** have fashionable labels on) **with plain white or black shorts underneath**. If it going to be a reliably warm day children may just come in their shorts. On their top halves children should wear a **white T shirt with our school crested jumper or cardigan on top**. **Trainers should be worn on their feet with a pair of pumps in their school bag** if there is a change in the weather meaning that the afternoon PE lesson will take place in our school hall. If pumps are not brought the child will do indoor PE barefooted. If your child does not have any of these items they may attend in usual school uniform and we will provide them with one of our spare PE kits for the lesson. If children come to school wearing PE clothes which are not as described above they will given correct PE kit items from school to wear.

## Financial Help

We recognise that during this and upcoming financial crisis many lives are altering. If you find that you are claiming any of the benefits below, your school aged child/ren will qualify for **free school dinners and other financial help to help their education within school.**



The range of benefits which qualify you are:

- **Universal Credit** with a household income of less than £7,400 a year (after tax and not including any benefits you get)
- **Income-Based Jobseekers' Allowance**
- **Income-Related Employment and Support Allowance**
- **Child Tax Credit**, not entitled to Working Tax Credit and household income less than £16,190
- **Support under part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999**
- **Guarantee element of State Pension Credit**
- **Income Support**
- **Working Tax Credit 'run on'** – the payment you receive for a further four weeks after you finish work.
