Our Christmas Nativity

- We ask you to wear a mask whilst in our school for the play.
- The Government advise that all attendees take a lateral flow test before coming to school.

We are sorry but siblings and other children cannot be accommodated at our nativities this year. The Nativity tickets were sent home last week, if parents live in separate houses please ensure that the other parent gets a ticket.

COVID-19

If your child shows any of the below symptoms please keep your child at home and book them a PCR test.

Symptoms are

- A high temperature—this means you feel hot to the touch on your chest or back (you do not need to measure your temperature)
- A new, continuous cough—this means coughing a lot more than an hour, or 3 or more coughing episodes in 24 hours (if you usually have a cough, it may be worse than usual)
- A loss or change to your sense of smell or taste—this means you've noticed you cannot smell or taste anything, or things smell or taste different to normal

If your child shows any of these symptoms at school we will ring you immediately and expect you to come and collect your child.
